

Misc. Questions

- What are the office hours at City Hall?

The City Hall office is open Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 4:30pm. There is a drop box located at the rear entrance of the building that can be utilized for making payments after hours.

- What are the phone numbers to other local utility departments?

- Does the City of Kingsford require dogs to be licensed?

Yes. Michigan state law requires all dogs in the state to be licensed.

- How do I obtain a dog license?

Dog licenses can be obtained at Kingsford City Hall between the dates of November 1st and March 1st. After March 1st, dog licenses can be purchased through the Dickinson County Offices. Proof of the dog's current rabies vaccination is required to purchase a dog license. The rabies certificate is obtained from your veterinarian upon vaccination, and lists the rabies tag number and expiration date of the vaccination. The fee is \$5.00.

- How do I contact local council representatives?

Correspondence can be mailed directly to the City Hall offices at 305 S. Carpenter Avenue, Kingsford, MI 49802.

- Where do I go to vote?

Precinct #1 is designated to vote at City Hall (305 S. Carpenter Avenue) and Precinct #2 is designated to vote at the Public Works Building (1500 Carter Drive). Please contact the Kingsford City Hall at (906) 774-3526 if there are questions regarding which precinct a resident is designated to vote at.

- How do I obtain an absentee ballot to vote?

An application for an absentee ballot must be completed and returned to Kingsford City Hall in order to receive an absentee ballot (must have proof of identification present). The application can be obtained in person at City Hall or mailed by calling City Hall at (906) 774-3526. Once the completed application is received, the absentee ballot can be picked up at City Hall or mailed upon request. The completed ballot must be returned to City Hall no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
