Minutes of the special meeting of the city council of the City of Kingsford, County of Dickinson, and State of Michigan.

A special meeting of the Kingsford city council was held Wednesday, May 9, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. in the council room in City Hall.

Also present was City Manager Anthony Edlebeck, Dept. of Public Works Supt. Justin Wickman and Treasurer Holly Palmer.

There were no minutes, invoices, public comment, communications, manager's report or old business presented at this meeting.

Under New Business, the 2018-2019 Budget was discussed. City Manager Edlebeck provided a preliminary draft of the Appropriations Budget for July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019 along with the budget worksheets and provided a detailed explanation for each fund. Modifications will be made following any discussion prior to any publication of the public hearing.

A lengthy discussion took place regarding the proposed Capital Improvements. The City Council recommended completing the necessary electrical design and modifications at the Kingsford Public Safety building to accommodate a portable generator prior to the ADA entrance and bathroom remodeling. Also recommended was the addition to Major Streets of paving Woodward Avenue from Westwood Avenue to Balsam Street.


