Minutes of the special meeting of the city council of the City of Kingsford, County of Dickinson, and State of Michigan.

A special meeting of the Kingsford City Council was held Monday, November 12, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. in the council room at City Hall.

Roll Call: Present: Baldinelli, Erickson, Flaminio, Groeneveld and Dixon-Miller
Absent: none

Also present was City Manager Anthony Edlebeck, Brian Bousley and Joe Stevens.

The pledge of allegiance was stated.

A motion was made by Councilmember Baldinelli and supported by Councilmember Flaminio to approve the agenda as presented.

There were no minutes, invoices, consent agenda, communications or manager's report.

Under Public Comment, Mr. Joe Stevens addressed the importance of installing the temporary holding tanks at the airport.

There was no Old Business.

Under New Business, the City received a request from the Dickinson County Board dated November 7, 2018 to allow temporary septic system(s) at new hangars located at the Kingsford airport. City Manager Edlebeck distributed the airport's long-range plans showing 19 proposed hangars that include the MJ Electric and FedEx's hangar locations. Due to ground water at 10-feet and the late start of construction, it was decided to postpone the sewer system installation at this time. Permission is required by the City Council to install a holding tank as a temporary solution in order to avoid any delays to the hangar development and utilization this winter. The County would also like to apply for grant funding in order to offset some of the cost. A discussion took place.

A motion was made by Councilmember Baldinelli and supported by Councilmember Groeneveld to approve the installation of temporary holding tanks for the MJ Electric and FedEx's hangars for a maximum of 3 years so that permits may be issued by the Dickinson-Iron County Health Department.

Under Councilmember's Privilege, Councilmember Flaminio stated he has utilized the airport plenty recently. Councilmember Groeneveld wished the hunters good luck. Councilmember Baldinelli said the airport is important. Mayor Erickson said Happy Veterans Day.
