Minutes of the special meeting of the city council of the City of Kingsford, County of Dickinson, and State of Michigan.

A special meeting of the Kingsford City Council was called to order on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. in the conference room at City Hall.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Superintendent of Public Works vacancy and any other business that may come before the Council.

At 3:06pm, a motion was made by Councilmember Flaminio and supported by Baldinelli to recess as the City Council and reconvene as the Board of Review.

At 3:13pm, a motion was made by Councilmember Dixon-Miller and supported by Baldinelli to recess as the Board of Review to continue the Special Meeting of the City Council.

Under New Business, the Council discussed the Superintendent of Public Works vacancy. Mayor Erickson opened the meeting by asking if there should be any revisions to the current DPW Supt job posting, including the 2-year civil engineering degree and 5-10 years of construction or engineering experience. A discussion took place and was determined to continue advertising using the same posting language. It was further discussed that the current City Manager will be turning 63 soon, and the City Council may want to consider the possibility of hiring additional administrative staff to assist in a smooth transition upon Edlebeck's retirement. A lengthy discussion took place.


A motion was made by Councilmember Dixon-Miller and supported by Councilmember Baldinelli to advertise for interested applicants for the position of City Manager.
