There were no minutes, invoices, public comment, communications, manager's report or old business presented at this meeting.


Under New Business, the 2019-2020 Budget was discussed. City Manager Edlebeck provided a memo and a preliminary draft of the Appropriations Budget for July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 along with the budget worksheets and provided a detailed explanation for each fund.

A lengthy discussion took place regarding the Capital Improvement Fund and proposed projects. Modifications will be made following any discussion prior to any publication of the public hearing.

At the regular city council meeting to be held on May 20th, a public hearing re: 2019-2020 Appropriations Budget will need to be scheduled for June.

Under Councilmember's Privilege, Councilmember Baldinelli mentioned the proposed increases due to lead and copper rules and would like the city's bills to state "mandatory state charge". Councilmember Groeneveld wished Edlebeck an early 'Happy Birthday'.
