Minutes of the special meeting of the city council of the City of Kingsford, County of Dickinson, and State of Michigan.

A special meeting of the Kingsford City Council was held on Wednesday, May 19, 2021 at 4:30pm in the council chambers at City Hall.

The pledge of allegiance was stated.

There were no minutes, invoices, public comment, communications, manager's report or old business presented at this meeting.

The first item under New Business was a presentation for organizing the Kingsford 100-year anniversary. Tanya Hiltonen submitted a memo to the councilmembers and reviewed bullet points pertaining to the upcoming 100-year anniversary. A discussion took place.

A motion was made by Councilmember Baldinelli and supported by Councilmember Remer to authorize City Manager Stelmaszek to seek legal council from the City Attorney for the initial event planning stages. ALL AYES. NO NAYS. MOTION CARRIED.

The final item under New Business was the 2021-2022 Budget discussion.
